## **\*Rabies Vaccination Clinic\***

**Rabies Vaccinations: \$15 each**

**All dogs and cats must be on a leash, or in a crate – for safety.**

(Bring prior vaccination history to receive a 3-year vaccine, if your pet qualifies.

Otherwise, all vaccinations will be good for one year.)

## **\*Tickborne Disease Testing Clinic\***

**4DX Test (includes Heartworm test): \$25 each**

(This is a single blood test that tests your dog for the presence of three tick-borne diseases that have all been detected in western Massachusetts – Lyme disease; Anaplasmosis; and Ehrlichiosis. It also tests for the presence of Heartworm infection. You will be given a certificate verifying that your dog has been tested, and indicating the results.)

\*Six month supplies of topical flea/tick preventative (\$85) and heartworm preventative (\$45-\$65 depending on size) will also be available.\*
