Parking Details

Due to the construction work for the downtown garage structure, the Olive Street municipal parking lot is closed. Public parking is available at meters on Bank Row and in the municipal pay-and-display lots on Hope Street or behind the Town Hall.

Limited FRCOG guest parking is available in the lot above (east) of the JWO Transit Center (the parking lot for the brick building with Registry of Deeds office). The FRCOG has two visitor spots, #43 and #44, which are designated with signage. Otherwise, "pay to park" municipal lots are located on Hope Street (at the end of Olive Street), and behind the Town Hall. Both municipal lots have a pay-and-display system that is enforced from 8 am - 6 pm. Metered spots are available on Bank Row. Daytime meeting attendees may not use the short term parking in the JWO Transit Center parking lot unless they require handicapped spaces. After 5:30 pm evening meeting attendees may use the parking in the JWO Transit Center parking lot.
