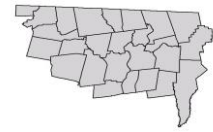

He added that they are accepting new members and there are opportunities to get trained to specific positions.</p> <p>c. FCECS Walter Tibbetts reported on the current state of the system. At the time of the meeting they system is stable and the FCECS Oversight Committee is working towards making improvements which will improve system reliability. There have been many conversations between EOPSS about what they can offer Franklin County if it decided to migrate to its radio system. At the time of the meeting EOPSS is still working on a fund plan and development schedule for the state-wide project so EOPSS cannot give specifics on cost and timeline to Franklin County.</p>
