



UPCOMING DATES AND LOCATIONS FOR LOCAL VACCINE CLINICS

Franklin County Clinics are open to all county residents. Appointments must be scheduled; absolutely no walk-ins allowed.

Greenfield. February 13 – March 05: Vaccinations continue at the Jon Zon Senior Center. Next week's schedule is February 13th, 09:00am to 04:00pm, February 17th, from 11:00am to 06:00pm, and February 19th, from 09:00am to 04:00pm.

Deerfield. Week of February 15: Clinic at Tree House Brewery. February 18 and 19, from 9:30am to 2:15pm.

KEY UPDATES *week ending 2/12*

- Phase 2 Local Clinics in the County are underway and off to a strong start. 1,000 vaccine doses were shipped to Franklin County for local clinics this past week. 500 doses were allocated to the FRCOG and another 500 to the City of Greenfield. This was 500 more doses than anticipated.
- The Greenfield Clinic, with support from the FRCOG, MRC volunteers, and other stakeholders in the region, added an additional day at the John Zon Community Center Clinic to administer the additional doses of vaccine.
- People 75 and older **and their caregivers** are now eligible for the vaccine. Vaccination of caregivers remains at the discretion of the vaccination clinic. Franklin County Clinics will vaccinate caregivers. Caregivers must register in advance and accompany the senior to their appointment in order to receive the vaccine.

OTHER VACCINATION SITES

Those able to travel are encouraged to schedule appointments at the **large throughput vaccination sites** at [UMass Amherst](#) and [The Eastfield Mall in Springfield](#).

Pharmacies, like [CVS](#) and [Big Y](#), are accepting appointments through their websites.

Franklin County **doctor's offices and health centers** are scheduling appointments with their patients. Please do not call about vaccinations. When vaccines and appointments are available, they will call you to schedule an appointment.

Vaccine doses shipped to MA are increasing by the week. As of 2/12/2021 a total of 1,503,925 doses have been shipped to MA and 1,034,018 have been administered. 7,100 of these doses have been shipped to Franklin County. This number does not accurately reflect the amount of vaccines that county residents have received as residents of the county may have traveled outside of the county to receive a vaccine.

FRANKLIN COUNTY VACCINATION PLAN
