The Franklin Regional Council of Governments is hosting a Virtual Public Information Meeting during a 21-day public comment period for the Draft FFY2022-2026 Transportation Improvement Program. The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the formal document that contains a listing of all federally funded road and bridge projects in Franklin County and of all transit projects for the Franklin Regional Transit Authority (FRTA).

The Virtual Public Information Meeting will be held remotely via Zoom on **Thursday, May 6, from 5:00 to 6:00 PM**. All are welcome and encouraged to attend, ask questions, learn about the TIP, and offer comments on the program of road, bridge and transit projects for 2022 through 2026.
