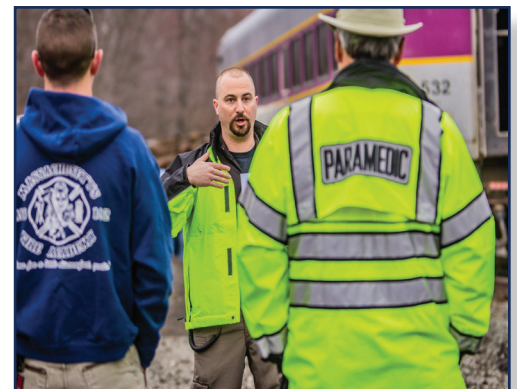


## Senior Emergency Preparedness Planner
