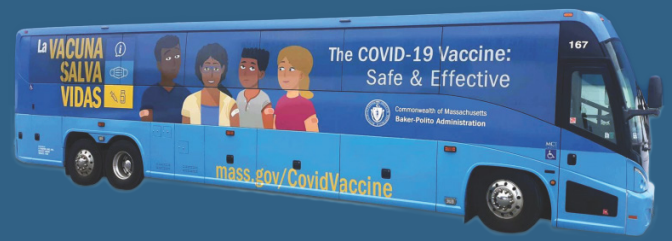


The VaxBus is headed back to the area!
