

# 2023 SECONDHAND SMOKE REGULATION

## SAMPLE REGULATION RESTRICTING SMOKING IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS

This sample regulation incorporates the minimum standards required pursuant to Massachusetts Smoke-Free Workplace Law (M.G.L. Chapter 270, Section 22), 105 CMR 661 and the 2018 state law that bans the use of electronic cigarettes wherever the state law applies as of June 2020.
